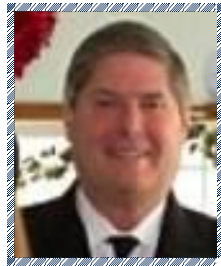


## From the Commodore's Bridge

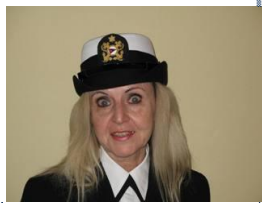

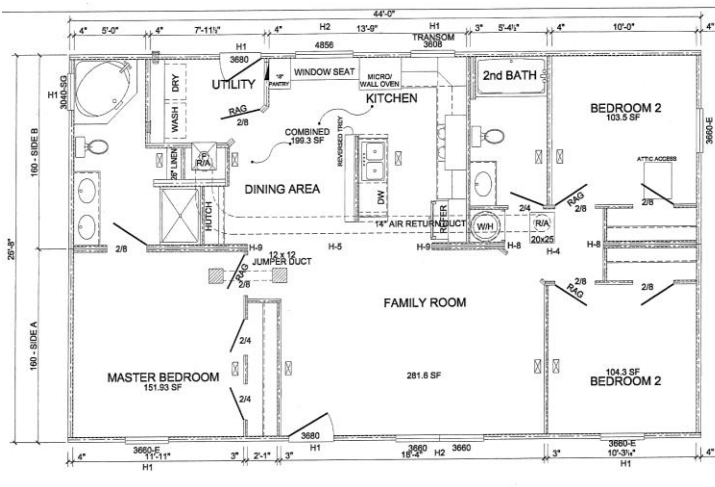

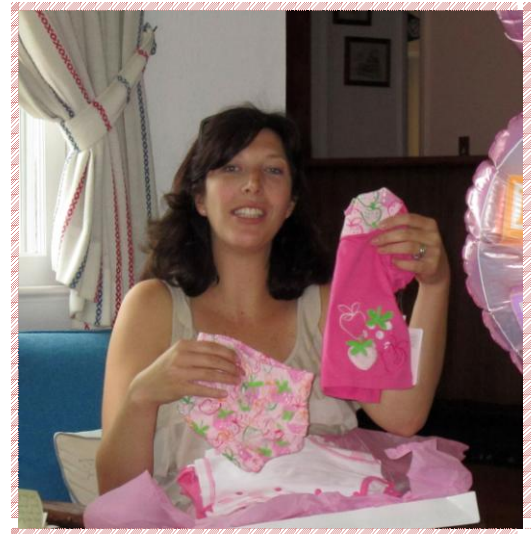
Floor Plan of the New Cottage 6
